The keynote speaker will be **Dr. Michael Horton**, the J. Gresham Machen Professor of Systematic Theology and Apologetics, at Westminster Seminary California and author of over thirty books. His two plenary addresses will be: *Are We Living in a “Secular Age”?* and *The Danger of “Spirituality”*.

Guidelines for a Paper Proposal

Approved papers will be presented at the ETS-NE’s Annual Meeting. Each presentation must be no longer than thirty minutes with an additional ten minutes used for questions and discussion. A copy of your paper or at least an outline should be provided to those present.

The proposal must contain the following information:

1. The title
2. The purpose of the paper
3. A concise *summary* of the paper (250-500 words)

Please include with your proposal the following personal information.

1. Name, address, e-mail, phone number
2. Are you a professor, student, pastor, or other? (specify)
3. Highest academic degree attained, and from where?
4. Present position, and institution
5. Are you a member of ETS?*
